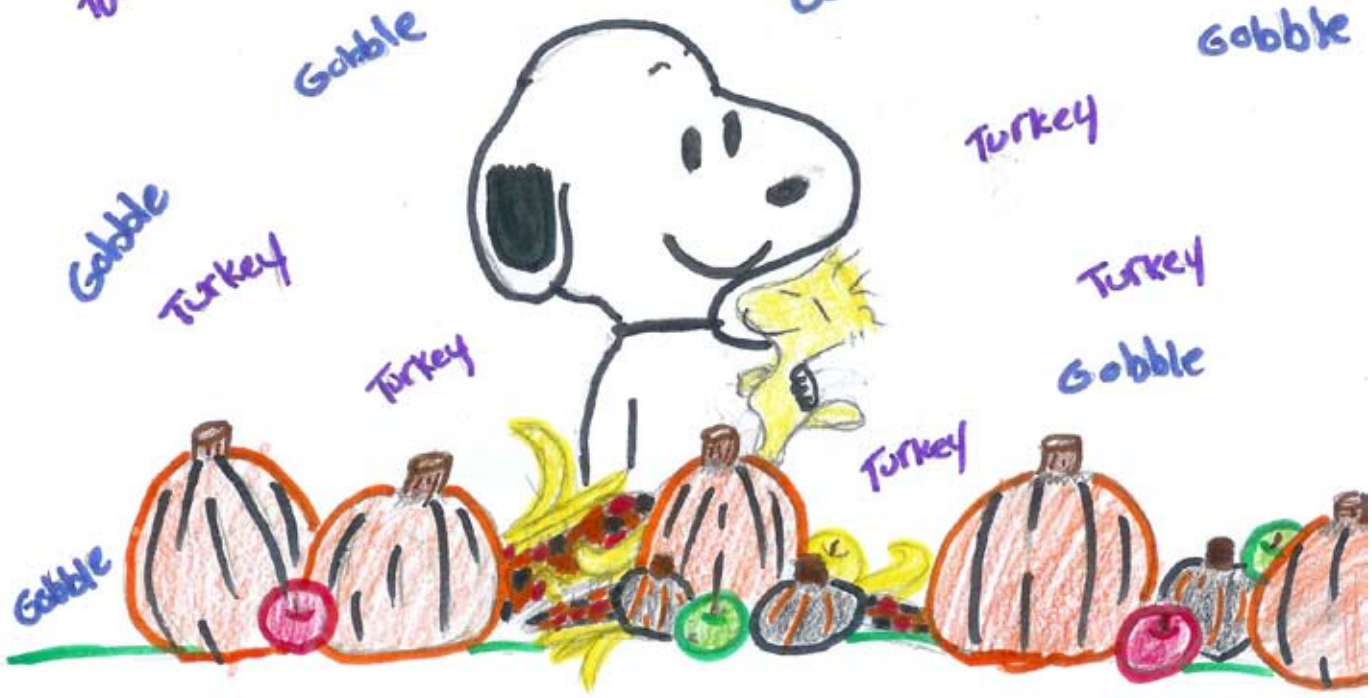

Mike Gaval, Mahanoy Area (Mahanoy City, Pa.) Northwest Area (Shickshinny, Pa.) simply had no answer for Gaval, a 5-foot-11, 160-pound senior quarterback who ran for a school-record 328 yards on just 13 carries in a 41-0 victory in the Eastern Conference Division I playoffs. Gaval had three touchdown runs and completed 3-of-6 passes for 75 yards and a score. His monster performance also gave him the single-season school rushing mark with 1,912 yards, passing the previous record of 1,584. He'll have a chance to add to it when the Bears play Nativity (Pottsville, Pa.) on Friday night.

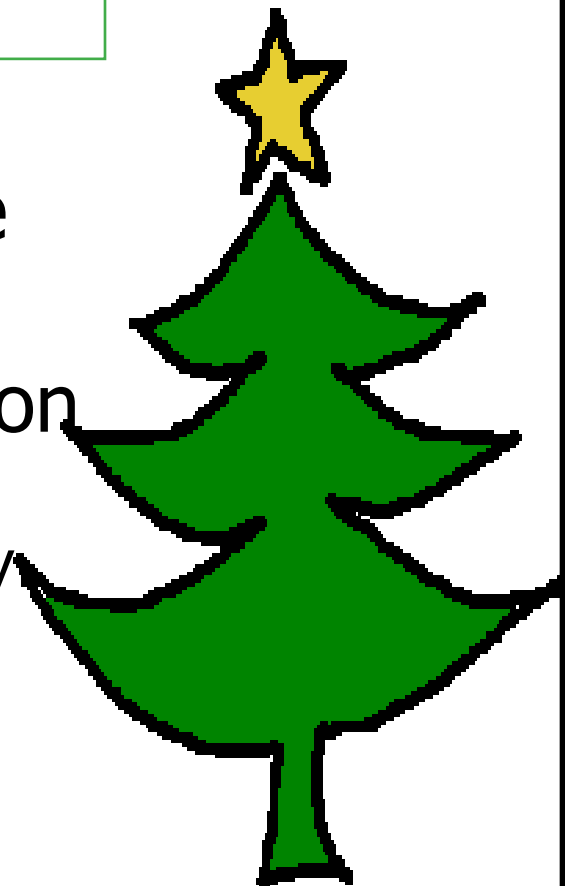

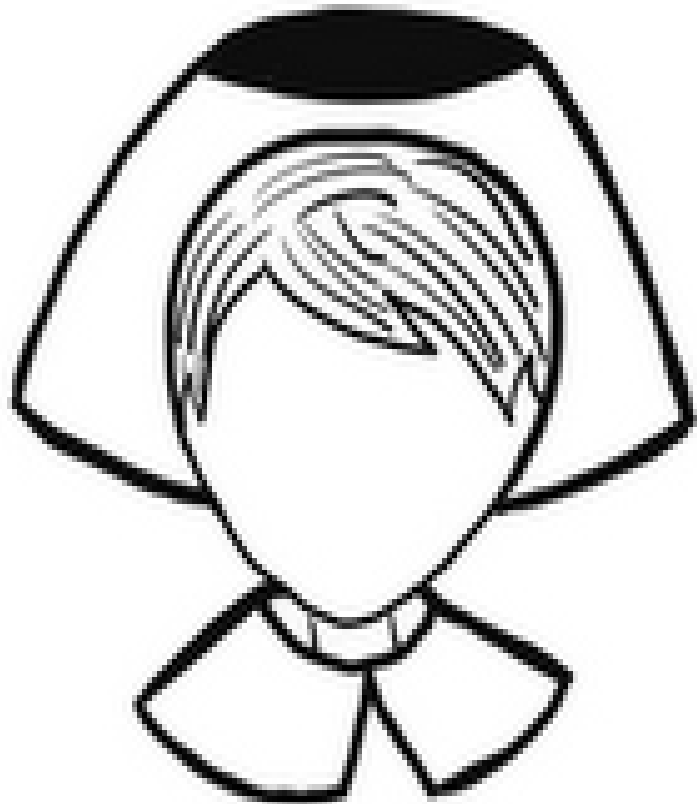
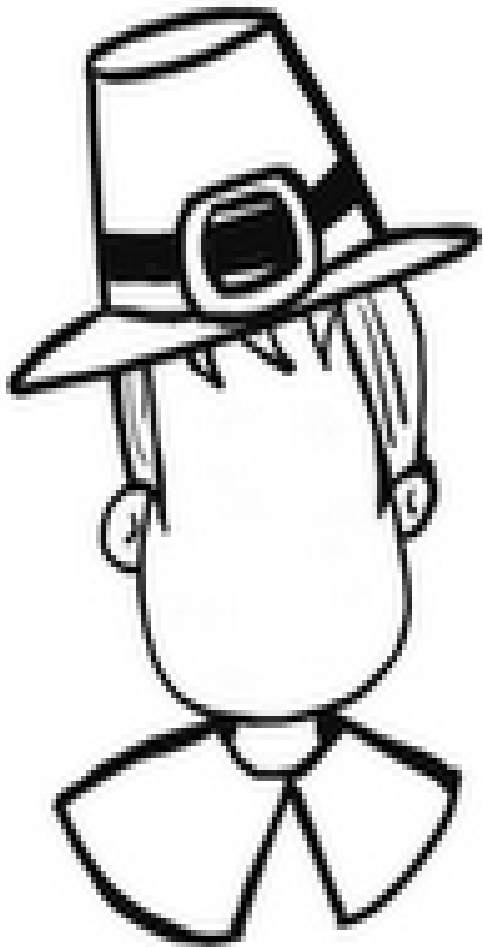
